The Dupont: Greenpoint's Waterfront Jewel

Complementing this cloud-level haven is a tranquil Garden Terrace – an impeccably curated space complete with barbecue stations and a plush lounge area, perfect for summer evening dinners, weekend gatherings, or a solo sunset glass of wine. With Newtown Barge Park just below and the entire East River unfolding beyond, The Dupont invites its residents to engage with outdoor life from every angle.
